## **“Special Populations Assessments and Child Find Timelines” for 2009-2010**

- ◆ **Gifted Identification**: The Kyrene School District conducts assessment for the identification of gifted students three times yearly. The three assessment windows for all students nominated for gifted identification for grades K through 8 are the months of **August 2009, January 2010** and **March 2010**. Students can be nominated by teachers, parents, or themselves. The gifted resource teacher or the middle school administrators facilitate the assessments during the time windows.
- ◆ **Child Find**: Child Find for possibly disabled children is also a legislative mandate at both the federal and state levels. Staff who suspects that a student may have an IDEA or 504 disability should contact the special education resource teacher or the school psychologist.
- ◆ **Monthly Preschool Screening**: Monthly screening for the identification of preschool children with disabilities is required within the district; please contact the preschool office at (480) 783-4156.
- ◆ **Algebra 1-2 and Honors Geometry**: The semester exams for these two high school level classes will be administered in **December 2009** and **May 2010**. Administration is during the regularly scheduled class periods. The tests are developed in conjunction with the Tempe Union High School District using a test bank agreed upon by both districts.
- ◆ **Spanish**: The 8th grade TUHSD/KSD Placement Spanish 1-2 Exam will be administered in **May 2010**. The content is based on the two-year curriculum expectations for students completing both 7th and 8th grade Spanish. All 8<sup>th</sup> grade students currently enrolled in Spanish take the Spanish 1-2 Exam which could potentially afford them placement and/or credit for high school Spanish within the Tempe Union High School District.

### **How was the calendar developed?**

The calendar represents numerous iterations and changes beginning with draft forms during spring 2009. Input from Kyrene staff members, elementary and middle school principals resulted in the Kyrene School District calendar and the required test dates.
