

This is a four-week continuation of the Kyrene Preschool Program available during the school year which typically developing and special needs preschoolers learn together in an environment designed for the most effective learning of the preschool age children. Typically developing children are those whose development is typical for their age and similar to other children in their age group. Special needs children are those whose development is delayed in one or more areas as compared to other children their age. Kyrene special needs preschool students who are eligible for Extended School Year services may attend free and will be given first priority for registration. Other students may register on a first-come, first-served basis.

Qualifications for admission:

In order to attend Kyrene Preschool Summer Academy, typically developing students must be at least four years old before June 1, 2009 and no older than a child who is eligible for Kindergarten in 2008-2009. Special needs students must be attending Kyrene Preschool during the 2007-2008 school year to participate. Kyrene Preschool Summer Academy will not be available to special needs students who will begin attending Kyrene Preschool during the 2008-2009 school year. Transportation must be provided by families with the exception of special needs students who are attending the program to receive Extended School Year services.
