- **Kyrene Altadeña** is holding a donation drive through its Academic Lab classes.
- **Kyrene Akimel A-al** is holding a Student Council drive for the American Red Cross
- **Kyrene Aprende** -- Student Council and National Junior Honor Society organizing drive for loose change, dollars, or checks. Grade levels will compete with each other and the administrative team.
