Kyrene School District students take 7 of 11 Top Spots in State-wide Algebra Contest”

Seven students from two Kyrene Elementary School District middle schools are among the top eleven students in Arizona on the 2009 AATM State Algebra Contest. There were over 1000 participants from across the state who reported scores.
