Dear Mirada Families:

Following the roof collapse at Waggoner Elementary School on Monday, March 16, Dr. Schauer sent a letter to the community outlining immediate plans to inspect all Kyrene buildings. The type of inspection ordered is a more extensive inspection than the state requires.

As part of this process, Gervasio and Associates (consulting engineers) and Porter Construction performed a preventative inspection of Mirada yesterday afternoon. Through this inspection, it was determined that some preventative maintenance in the Mirada Multi-Purpose Room needed to be performed and that shoring needed to be installed below one of the bar joists. While we were assured that the room was safe for occupancy, we made sure that the work would be done as soon as possible, and it was completed by 10:30AM this morning. The shoring is located close to the west wall, near the south end of the building.

As part of our District Capital Improvement Plan, Mirada was already scheduled to receive a new roof this summer. All work will be completed prior to the 2009-2010 school year. We are doing whatever it takes to make sure that every building in Kyrene is as safe as possible for all of our students.
