Dear Monte Vista Staff and Families:

Following the roof collapse at Waggoner Elementary School on Monday, March 16, our superintendent, Dr. David Schauer, sent a letter to the community outlining immediate plans to inspect all Kyrene buildings. The type of inspection ordered is a more extensive inspection than the state requires.

As part of this process, Gervasio and Associates (consulting engineers) and Porter Construction performed a preventative inspection of Monte Vista on April 9. Through this inspection, it was determined that some preventative maintenance was needed at the east entry of the multi-purpose room. A wood shoring post was installed on Friday, April 10. The shoring removed the weight of the roof from this area of the wall. Work was completed as soon as possible, and we are assured the area is safe for occupancy. To determine appropriate repairs, further review and investigation by our structural engineers and construction company will take place.
