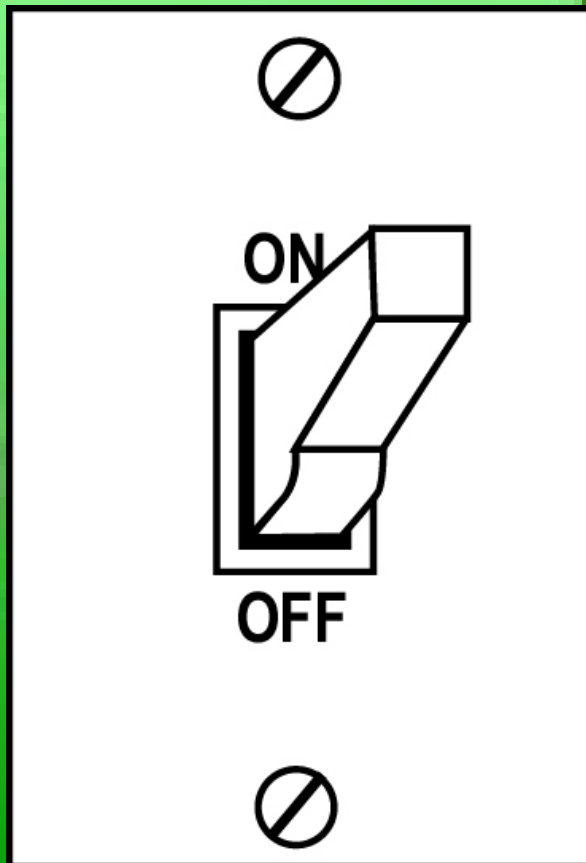
Did you know?



- Lighting accounts for about 20% of all electricity use in the country and about 15% of electricity use in our homes.
- Inefficient incandescent light bulbs waste money and energy because they are actually heaters in disguise, converting 90% of the electricity to heat and only about 10% to visible light.
- By replacing four standard bulbs with Compact Fluorescent Light (CFL) bulbs, you can prevent the emission of 5,000 pounds of carbon dioxide and reduce your electricity bill by more than \$100 over the lives of those bulbs.
