- The post walk assembly will begin at 7:30am, please plan on arriving in time to attend the assembly.

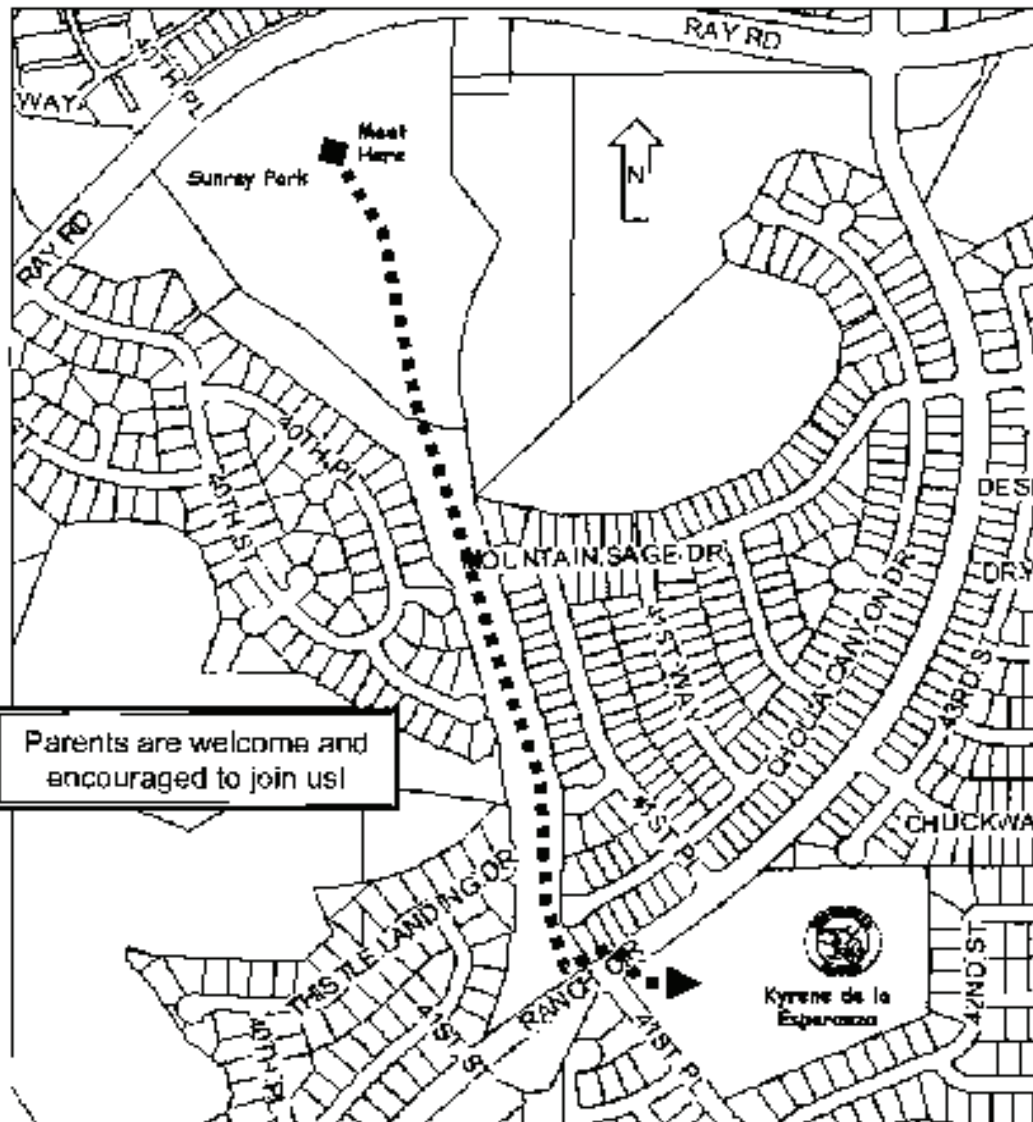
