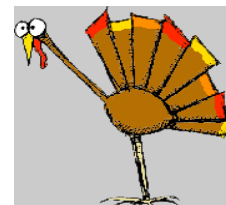

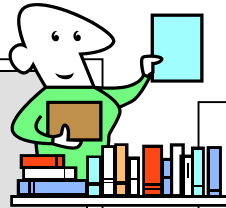

The Sierra Team Fit Kids is well under way and we have been running for 2 weeks at Sierra now. The kids have done a great job and have logged over **828 miles!**

The Response to this program has been very positive and it is great to see so many kids out there running. Kids should be registered for the first two races – Iron Kids on 11/21 and PF Changs Kids Rock on 1/16. We also have posted all of the running club information on the Sierra Website to make it easier for parents to access.

Here are a couple of quick reminders that will help with the mileage tracking:

- At home yellow running logs must be initialed by a parent (this is only for miles run **OUTSIDE** of running club) **IMPORTANT CHANGE**; while the charity recognizes and applauds the fitness level of our students, they will only honor **running/jogging miles** going forward and not the 15 minutes of exercise or recreational sports and will cap this at 8 miles per week.
- Please remind kids that they have running club on Monday's and Wednesday and to wear tennis shoes on those days
- The charity is not equipped to provide replacement shoe charms or shoe keepers if these are lost. Part of this is program is to help teach the kids responsibility
