Our Classroom Rules

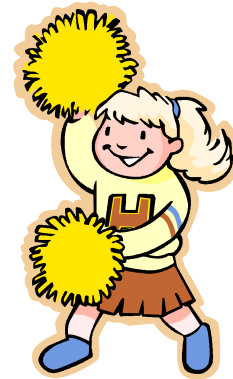

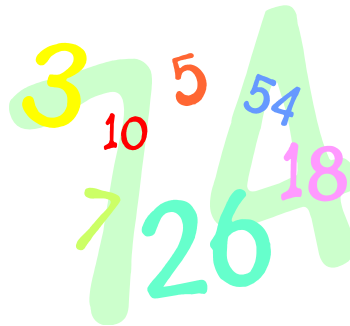
Math



Writing Workshop

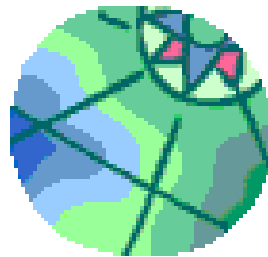
- ▶ Writer's Workshop which includes a mini-lesson, independent writing time, and time for sharing

Language Arts

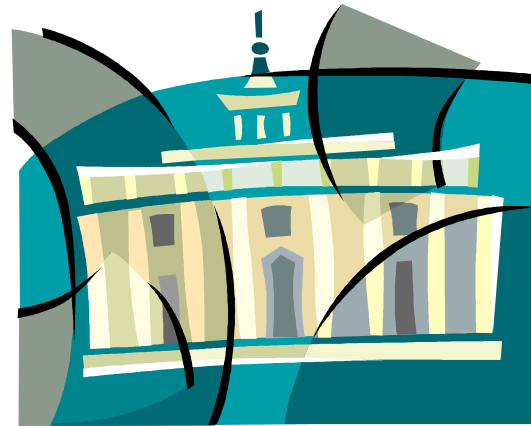
- ▶ Anthology (Harcourt Trophies)

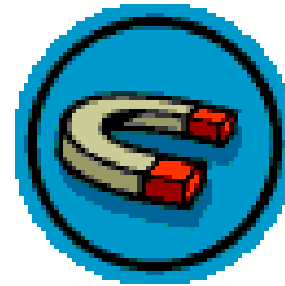
