

Music Rules and Expectations

Students are expected to follow the following rules in music class:

1. Participate using your personal best
2. Show respect to others with kind words and actions
3. Use active listening
4. Play instruments as instructed

Students will receive the following consequences when they choose not to follow rules:

- 1st Offense – Teacher will verbally remind student what is expected
- 2nd Offense – Student will complete a lesson sheet outlining the steps for following whatever rule was broken. The lesson sheet will go home for a parent signature.
- 3rd Offense – Student will complete a second lesson sheet outlining the steps for following whatever rule was broken. The lesson sheet will go home for a parent signature. Parents will also be notified by email or telephone.
- 4th Offense – Student will be removed from music class

All students start fresh each music class. If a student fails to return a lesson sheet by the next music class, s/he will be given a “Responsibility” lesson to complete before joining the class.

Rewards:

Three students’ names will be drawn each class period. These students will receive a Music Star Award. Students can only receive this award if they have not broken any class rules that day. These students’ names are then placed in a drawing to be held at the end of each quarter for small prizes.
