House Project

INTRODUCTION

Congratulations, you have just won a new house! There is one catch before you can take possession of your humble abode. You have to design, build, and decorate your house. It has no floor covering, doors, appliances, bathroom fixtures, or any of the luxuries you have come to rely on in your current home. You are given access to walls and a roof free of charge, everything else is up to you.

TASK

You must decide what you want in your house and then find out the cost of the products. You will only have **\$50,000** to spend to make your house a home and not one penny more.

DESIGN

Your house can be designed to meet your needs but it must include the following:

- At least 1,600 square feet.
- At least three bedrooms (master, office, guest, child, etc..)
- At least 2 bathrooms
- Kitchen
- Living room
- Garage (not included in square footage)
- Closets
- Flooring (all floors must be covered in carpet, tile, wood, etc..)
- Paint
- Furniture (all rooms need to be completely furnished)
- You need to completely outfit your house (door knobs, plants, lights, doors, ceiling fans, light fixtures, countertops, etc..)
- You DO NOT need to buy a hot water heater, air conditioner, or cabinets.
- All purchases must be new material purchased off Elliott's Vendor List

TIPS

- You may want to write down items that you have around your own house to get ideas before doing any shopping.
- Buy large items first because they will take up a majority of your money then go with the smaller items to give your house a style that reflects your personality.

Excel Expense Report

All items purchased must be included in your Expense Report. You will be provided a blank Excel Report that is ready for you to enter all purchases. Items must be included under the appropriate tab/room of the report (i.e., Refrigerator goes in the kitchen). For each item, enter its description, the unit cost, the total number needed, the total cost and the website where the item was found.

PowerPoint

Must include:

- A title slide (with your name and class period)
- A slide for each room (or type of room) in the house which includes:
 - A picture of all purchased items for that room (including flooring and paint)
 - A subtotal for all money spent on that room.
- A slide that includes the blueprint for the entire house
- A total slide which includes the total amount of money spent and what money is left over.

SCORING

Attached is a copy of the scoring rubric. Look it over and determine the requirements you want to meet in order to receive the score you want. You will have some time in class to work, but to get the grade you probably want you will need to put in extra time. Some of you have the programs we will be using at home (excel, PowerPoint, the Internet). If you have all of these consider yourself lucky. If you do not have these programs you are more than welcome to work on your project in my classroom, Monday- Thursday mornings before school and possibly some days after school. **Projects are DUE by the end of the day on Thursday May 18th.**
