

## Transferring Picture/Video Files from a smartphone to a Computer Desktop

- All Smartphones come with USB cable or you must be having one that works with all phones. Connect this USB sync cable to your Smartphone and connect it with the computer. Once connected, the notification area on your phone will show the USB icon (iPhone will ask if you “trust this computer” (say yes).
- Android- Tap this notification bar on your phone and drag it down and tap it. Tap USB connected next and then tap Mount.
- The Micro-SD card of your Smartphone will be listed as a **removable disk** in My Computer.
  - All you have to do is click Start and then go to My Computer.
- Click on the removable disk and you will **folder named DCIM**.
- Click DCIM and then click on Camera (iPhone- Look through the folders).
- Next transfer all the video taken from your camera to the desktop of the computer
