Wednesday, May 2

2:00 - 3:30 p.m.

***After school, **make welcome posters** and study session.*
Call Mrs. Vanover directly w/ any questions on her cell.

6:45 p.m.

Approximate arrival time. We will send a group text once we know their arrival time. Meet at school to eat together. We will provide hamburgers, hot dogs & buns and eating utensils. **Each family needs to bring a side dish to share (for 8) and one 2 liter juice, pop, or water. Please make sure all of our guests are served first,** before we begin serving ourselves.

(after dinner)

Free time with families. Students **must be accompanied by a responsible adult during free time and need to be home by 10:00 p.m. each night.** This first night they will be tired, so think about quiet activities you can do at home after returning home. Please plan to wash your partner's t-shirt that they wore today sometime tomorrow so that it will be ready for them to wear on Friday.

Thursday, May 3

9:15 a.m.

Arrive at school. Meet in the pit. **Wear our FAB t-shirt today! Bring money for lunch at the AZ Mills Food Court** for you **and** your partner *if* you are hosting. Also bring a water bottle for you and your partner, (**money for shopping for yourself only, your partner brings their own money for shopping**) etc.

9:30 a.m.

Leave for the Arizona Sea Aquarium at AZ Mills Mall.

10:00 a.m.

Tour of Sea Aquarium & workshop session.

1:00 p.m.

Lunch at the AZ Mills Food Court. Please show your partner all of the food options and be ready to **pay for their (and your own) lunch.** We will sit together as a group and eat in the Food Court.

1:30 – 4:00 p.m.

Shopping in the mall. You will need to shop in small groups. Mrs. Vanover and Mrs. Rascon will be in the Food Court and/or walking around the mall in case you have problems or questions. You can also call Mrs. Vanover on her cell at any time. **Stay with your partner and have at least one adult with you in your group.**

4:00 p.m.

Free time with families. Parents will need to pick students up at AZ Mills at 4:00. Please carpool! It is **VERY IMPORTANT that you check out (in person or call me on my cell) with Mrs. Vanover or Mrs. Rascon when you leave the AZ Mills Food Court today.** Please make arrangements to be picked up **by an adult.** Students must be accompanied by a responsible adult during free time.

6:30-9:00 p.m.

Meet at Jakes Unlimited tonight, 1830 E Baseline Rd, Mesa 85204. Please carpool! Admission for you and your partner and our Mexican guests will be paid for by the club (which includes dinner). Other family members are welcome to attend but will need to purchase their admission: \$10 for buffet only, OR \$20 for buffet, bowling, & unlimited video games and rides & attractions (however, it does NOT include the games that give out tickets for prizes).

9:00 p.m.

Free time with families. **Students must be accompanied by a responsible adult during free time and need to be home by 10:00 p.m.**

Friday, May 4

9:15 a.m.

Arrive at school. Meet in the pit. **IF you are hosting a Mexican guest, bring \$2.75 for lunch in the cafeteria** for your guest. Also bring an extra **water bottle** for you and your guest, hat, sunscreen, etc. **Note: IF you are NOT hosting a Mexican guest, you may choose to arrive at school as usual and go to your first period class.**

9:30 a.m.

Meet with 8th grade Spanish classes for a Baile Folklórico presentation by the Mexican students. Repeat with 6th grade students period 3. After the presentation we will work on the FAB tiled wall.

11:15 a.m.

Scavenger hunt around the school & finish work on FAB tiled wall.

11:45 a.m.

Lunch in the cafeteria. **Bring \$2.75 for your guest if you are hosting.** You will be able to stay all of 7th AND 8th grade lunches, to give the Mexican students a chance to meet all of your friends.

12:48-1:40 p.m.

Attend 5th period class of your choice (be sure to talk with the teacher ahead of time!) IF you choose to attend P.E., make sure your partner brings appropriate clothing to participate. If you are NOT hosting a Mexican student, go to YOUR regular 5th period class.

1:45 p.m.

Everyone meet in the D1 classroom. English/Spanish lesson, craft activities, games, etc. We may also play in the gym.

3:45 p.m.

If you are NOT hosting a partner, you will go home from school as usual at 3:30. If you ARE hosting, **your parent or another responsible adult may pick you up today at 3:45 pm. Free time with families.** We suggest that you plan to get together in small groups tonight – maybe rent a movie, have dinner together, etc. Other ideas: bowling, shopping, a museum, etc.

Saturday, March 25

11:00 a.m.

Meet at the pool/park area just west of Ray Rd. and E. Thunderhill Pl., just west of Monte Vista Elementary School. Bring a hat, sunscreen, bathing suit if you want to swim, water bottle, sports equipment (there is a park, pool and a volleyball court).

1:00 p.m.

Free time with families. Please arrange to be picked up by a responsible adult (please carpool). We suggest going shopping, sight-seeing, etc. It is more fun to spend time together in groups, so please talk with each other and get together in small groups! You are welcome to stay later at the park *if accompanied by an adult.*
You must check out with Mrs. Vanover or Mrs. Rascon in person!

7:30-10:00 p.m.

HATB Fiesta. **Everyone please bring one 2 liter bottle of pop, water OR juice AND a snack to share.** Parents and siblings are welcome to attend. Please make arrangements to be picked up by an adult. We will do a *program evaluation tonight during the last ½ hour of the party.* ****Adults, please arrive by 9:30** so that you can be part of the evaluation.
