

## **Homework**

The purpose of homework is to provide additional practice on previously introduced skills or to enrich classroom experiences. Homework includes activities such as brief drills, reading, collecting information, sharing ideas with parents and guardians, and providing projects/assignments in which students must utilize their time in creative thought.

An additional purpose of homework is to encourage the student to develop effective study skills, self-discipline, work ethic, and individual discovery habits, which are integral and indispensable elements of a quality education. The student is responsible for understanding homework expectations before leaving school and for completing the assignment on time. Parents and guardians can support the homework program by providing the student with time necessary to complete the work and by providing a quiet, well-lighted place to study.
