

## **Homework**

Homework packets will be given on Mondays and due Friday. The packet will usually include math, reading, and spelling assignments. Students are expected to complete a reading chart to track the minimum number of expected minutes a week. They are welcome to bring books home from the class or school library. Please remember, the kids will also need to study at home for the weekly spelling test.

As a class, we will review the homework assignments the day it is due. Homework that is not completed by the first school bell will be considered late. Late homework will not be awarded full credit. Students will not call parents for homework left at home. Please contact me if there are any questions or concerns regarding homework.

Book reports will be assigned separately and will appear on your child's agenda.

## **Parent Involvement**

The homework sent home is directly aligned to our class's learning. It should all be independent work. If any portions seem difficult, please remember to write a note on the bottom of the page so we may discuss it. Homework needs to be completed in its' entirety, following all directions, and neatly for a proficient grade on the report card. This work should help you know what your child can do on their own, and where they need more work. The reading logs need to be filled out by your child as well, not the parent.

Parents are not expected to act as experts regarding content. You as parents can ask clarifying questions and questions that help students summarize what they have learned.
