

Math Fact Fluency Practice: ADDITION MEMORY

(addition practice for grades 1-3)

Players: groups of 2 -5

Materials: regular deck of cards, no jokers, Ace = 1, Jack = 11, Queen = 12, King = 13 (*you can play with or without the face cards, depending on level*)

How to Play: Shuffle the deck and deal out the entire deck of cards face down in a 13x4 array. *If you do not use the face cards, make a 10x4 array.*

First person turns over a pair of cards and finds the sum of the two cards. Then, he/she turns over two more cards. If the sums match, player 1 wins the four cards and takes another turn.

If the sums do not match, all four cards are flipped back over and the next player takes a turn. Play continues until no more matches can be made.

Winner is the player with the most cards!
