

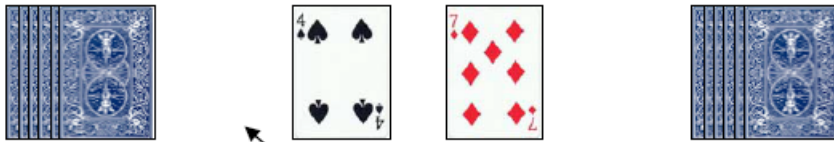
Math Fact Fluency Practice: OVER-UNDER
(multiplication practice for grades 3-5)

Players: partners of 2

Materials: regular deck of cards, no jokers, Ace = 1, Jack = 11, Queen = 12, King = 13 (You can play with or without the face cards, depending on level)

How to Play: Deal out entire deck face down giving half to each partner.

Decide which player is going to be the 'Under 30' person and who will be the 'Over 30' person.



Player 1: Under 30

Player 2: Over 30

The product is under 30. Player 1 keeps the cards.

Each player turns over a card at the same time and the two numbers are multiplied together. If the product is less than 30, the Under 30 player keeps the cards. If the product is greater than 30, the Over 30 player keeps the cards.

If the answer is exactly 30 each player takes back their card and places it back in their deck.

When all the cards have been used the person with the most cards is the winner.
