IB UPDATE:

SUMMER FOOD SERVICE:

The District is excited to announce that we will have an open feeding site at Kyrene de los Niños. Breakfast will be served from 7:45 – 9:15 and lunch 11:25 – 1:00 pm Monday through Thursday. Any child under the age of 18 can come to Niños and receive breakfast and lunch for free. This is permitted because Niños has a free and reduced population over 50%. Adults may also eat but they pay the regular adult fee for meals; \$3.50 for lunch and \$2.00 for breakfast. In addition to the meals prepared for the community, SFE will also be preparing meals for Jumpstart (pre-K) students in the month of June and the Tempe ACES meals (June and July) that are served at their site in Tempe. As long as SFE is onsite preparing meals it just feels right that we are also feeding the community. This is a test this first year with strong support from ADE, and depending upon interest we may expand to other school sites next summer
