Computer Homework:

In computer classes, there is almost no "homework" assigned since you must have access to a computer and the appropriate software to complete the lessons. However, deadlines will be given on assigned lessons. Students may be required to utilize their study hall or come in before or after school to complete projects on assigned due dates.

Do your own work:

When working on tests, quizzes or assignments that are to be done individually, students need to make sure that they are doing their own work. If you have a question during a test or quiz, do not ask your neighbor, raise your hand and ask Mr. Davison. Cheating will result in an automatic zero for that specific assignment, quiz or test.

Attend class and be on time:

Students must be on time to all classes, no exceptions! The first tardy is a warning; the next is a detention. If you need to go to the restroom, go BEFORE you come to class I will not consider you tardy if you are late to class for this reason. (within reason)

Absences:

Pre-arranged: Students must complete work in advance.

Excused: Students will be permitted to make up all work.

Unexcused: Students must make up the work and will not receive credit.

It is the responsibility of the student, on the first day of attendance following a non-truancy absence, to arrange for make up work of all missed school work. Failure of the student to make up the missed work will result in a "0" grade for the missed work. Make up work is due two (2) days after a one day absence.

Keep school property in good repair:

Computers, headphones, keyboards, mice, mouse pads, chairs, desks and books are to be kept free from defacing and demolition.

Students are not allowed to copy school software programs, use another student's login ID, tamper with another student's or teacher's password or files, "hack" into network files, use any type of e-mail or use unauthorized flash drives in any of the school computers. **Students may not access the Internet or play computer games in any of Mr. Davison's classes without proper consent of the instructor. Disobeying this rule will result in an immediate detention.**

Clean up your work area at the end of class.

No food, drink, candy or gum is allowed in class.

Follow directions:

Throughout the semester students will be given verbal and written instructions. Verbal instruction will typically only be given once; if you need additional instruction or clarification please ask! If a student is not paying attention, then the instruction will not be repeated. Students who feel comfortable enough to work ahead in class, will be expected to fix their own mistakes without interrupting instruction.
