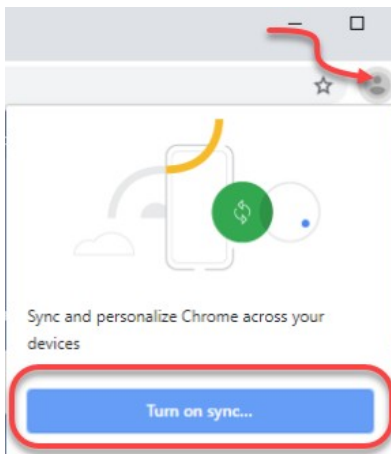

## Installing Read&Write for Google Chrome

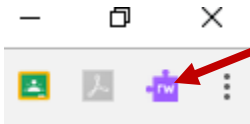
1. Launch the Chrome Browser.



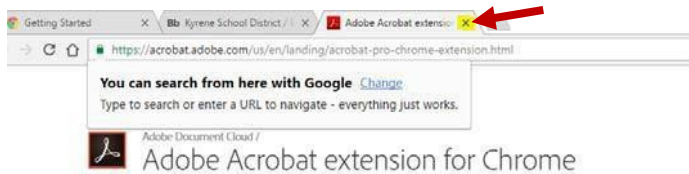
2. To sign in to Chrome, **click on the icon** in the top right corner of Chrome. If prompted, sign in with your Kyrene email and password. If not, click on **Turn on sync...**



- When the *Turn on Sync?* menu appears, press **Yes, I'm in**.
- Wait for the rw extension icon to appear in the top right corner



- Adobe Acrobat will open in a new tab. Close the tab with the Adobe Acrobat Extension



- Click on the purple RWicon



- If you see a screen like this one, click Allow



- Close out of Chrome.
- Open Chrome and then select the RW icon to open the tool bar.
