As an incentive for this program, the Kyrene School District offers:

- A guaranteed ride home for any employee who uses alternative mode to get to work in the event of an illness, family emergency, or other unforeseen problems
- Bicycle parking
- Showers and lockers for those who bike or walk to work (where available)
- An information center with bus, carpooling, zip code matching, high pollution advisories and more.
- Monthly prize drawings for new and continuing alternative mode users, Best AMU and moving closer to your site.
