Parent Reminders

Opt in for text communication

IMPORTANT: In the event of an emergency, text messages are the fastest and most effective way to communicate information to families. You must opt in to receive text communications! Text "Y" or "yes" to 67587 to begin receiving text messages from both your child's school and the Kyrene School District.

Birthday Celebrations

No celebrations of individual student birthdays are to be held in classrooms, on the school campus. We understand that parents and friends like to celebrate various occasions. However, cakes, cookies, cupcakes, candy, flowers, balloons, etc. cause many distractions and cannot be allowed on campus or on the bus. These items are disruptive in the classroom and are a safety concern on the bus. If they are delivered they will be kept in the office for parents/guardians to pick up. This policy helps to ensure that instructional time is protected and that all students are treated equally. Party invitations may not be distributed at school.


Need to Report an Absence?

Call our 24 Hour Attendance Line at 480-541-4201 to report a student absence.

Please leave a message on the attendance line indicating the student's name, grade, date(s) and reason for absence. When your student is absent and we have not received notification, we will contact the parents. If we do not receive a return phone call, the student will be marked truant. **Note** Parents MUST call the attendance line within 24 hours of an absence, even if you spoke to the Health Office or communicated to the Teacher.

Tardy

If your child is tardy, you must park in the parking lot and walk your child to the office. Sign them in and provide the reason why they are tardy. A tardy is defined as arriving at school or class after the scheduled start time. Students should be in their seats and ready to learn when the bell rings at the scheduled start time. Students are considered tardy if they are not in their seats at the scheduled start time. Mirada students need to arrive with enough time to make it to their classroom by 7:30am. Students who are tardy must enter through the school's front office and receive a Tardy pass.



Mirada Leadership Academy is a Leader in Me School. We focus and practice the 8 Habits of a Happy Kid. The beginning of the year is spent with a quick review of each habit so the children will begin practicing all habits ubiquitously throughout their learning day as well as when they leave our campus. Each month is dedicated to diving deeper into understanding each of the 8 habits.

Habit 1: Be proactive - we teach the children they are to "be in charge of me".

Habit 2: Begin with the end in mind - have a plan and set goals "A goal without a plan is just a wish".

Habit 3: Put first things first - work first, and then you get to play.

Habit 4: Think win-win - "I win, you win, we all win".

Habit 5: Seek first to understand, then to be understood - listen before you speak

Habit 6: Synergize - working together is better than working alone

Habit 7: Sharpen the saw - "Balance feels best"

Habit 8: Find yourtwitter.com/theleaderinme voice, inspire others' to find theirs - make a positive difference in your world.

When children live these habits at school and at home they are beginning to make the paradigm shift for success. We teach children that everyone can be a leader, not just a few. Everyone has genius, not just a few are gifted. The change must start with them, not rely on someone else to make the change. We empower our students to lead their own learning by setting goals and following the steps to achieve their goals, we do not direct and control their learning. We work with our families to develop the whole person, not just focusing on academics.

Community Education Enrollment Changes for Kids Club

Planning for the 2024-25 school year is already underway, and we want to make you aware of changes to enrollment for Community Education. Beginning this year, all Community Education programming (including Kids Club, After Hours, and Community and Signature Preschool) will open registration on the same day that general enrollment begins: January 9!

Another change this year will ensure all Kyrene families have an equal opportunity to register for before and after school programming, which can fill up quickly. In fairness to families who have been waitlisted in past years, there will be no pre-registration option for currently enrolled students this year. Registration for Kids Club and After Hours for the 2024-25 school year will open for all students on January 9 at 6:30 a.m. in

the Community Ed registration portal.

Families enrolling students in Community or Signature Preschool programs will also register through the Community Ed registration portal on January 9. If you are registering a child for Integrated Preschool or looking to change Kyrene schools, that can be done through the Kyrene general enrollment portal. Please note that Summer 2024 program registration will open March 4, 2024.
