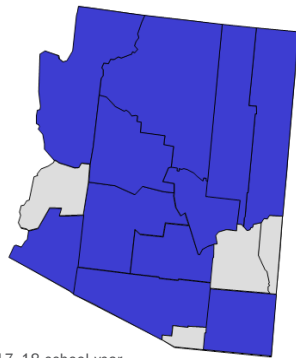

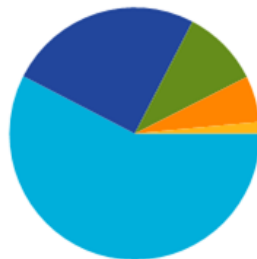

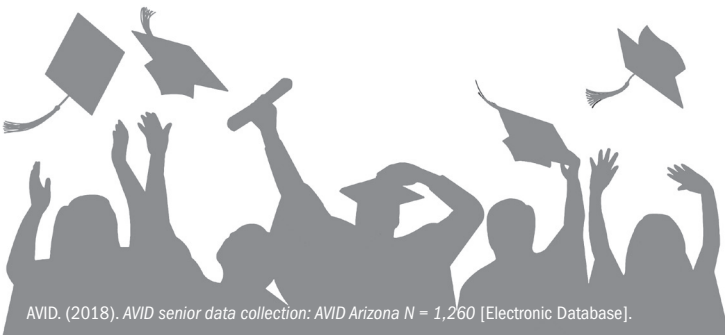
### Race/Ethnic Identity of Arizona AVID Students

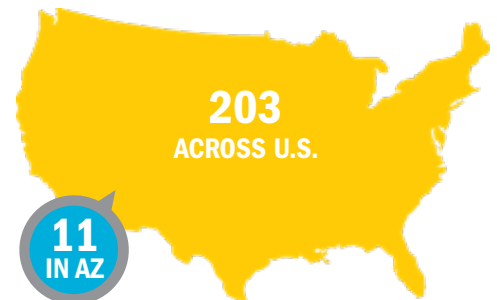

## AVID National Demonstration Schools

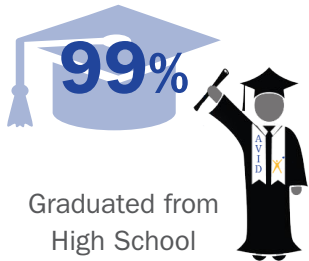
