<u>CLASS SUMMARY:</u>
<p>The Bus Driver, Family in Transition (FIT) is a standalone transportation class. Incumbents are responsible for driving vehicles other than school buses transporting homeless children between District schools and shelter locations on nonscheduled routes with irregular scheduled times.</p> <p>Duties include activities such as driving vehicles other than school buses on non-scheduled routes and for irregular trips; inspecting, fueling buses, and cleaning vehicles; monitoring the behavior of students; performing vehicle evacuations; and maintaining records related to incidents, mileage, and vehicle discrepancies.</p> <p>The Bus Driver Family in Transition is distinguished from other transportation classes in the primary focus on operating vehicles for the transportation of homeless children.</p>

<u>ESSENTIAL DUTIES:</u>	<u>PERCENT OF TIME</u>	<u>BAND/ GRADE RATING</u>
This class specification represents only the core areas of responsibilities; specific position assignments will vary depending on the needs of the department.		
Transports children to and from school and events from shelter locations including monitoring children and providing documentation for needed discipline by Administration; and reviewing route maps for time and place of student pickups and drop-offs.	Daily 60%	A/1
Inspects vehicles for readiness, safety and damage; and cleans interior of vehicles including washing windows, picking up trash, dusting and sweeping.	Daily 10%	A/1
Fills out forms including time sheets; bus information sheets; mileage, vehicle discrepancy, and incident, reports; seating charts, route sheets, and, as assigned, Medicaid billing.	Daily 10%	A/1
Fuels vehicles.	Weekly 5%	A/1
Participates in bus evacuation, radio, and first aid/CPR training and performs drills as assigned.	Monthly 5%	A/1
Performs other duties of a similar nature and level as assigned.	As Required

Training And Experience:

High School Diploma or GED is required; or, an equivalent combination of education and experience sufficient to successfully perform the essential duties of the job such as those listed above.

Licensing/Certification Requirements:

- AZ Driver's License;
- CPR Certificate with AED;
- First Aid Certificate;
- Classroom Instructor certification.

Knowledge of:

- Pertinent federal, state, and local laws, codes, rules, regulations, codes, and statutes;
- District policies, procedures, organization structure and school requirements;
- Vehicle driving principles and procedures;
- Safety procedures.

Skill in:

- Working under pressure to meet timelines and handling multiple and changing priorities;
- Driving a school vehicle;
- Managing student behavior in a vehicle;
- Establishing and maintaining harmonious working relationships with those contacted in the course of work; demonstrating tact, diplomacy and patience.

ADA and Other Requirements:

Positions in this class typically require: climbing, crawling, stooping, kneeling, crouching, fingering, standing, walking, pushing, reaching, lifting, feeling, talking, hearing, seeing, and repetitive motions.

Incumbents may be subjected to moving mechanical parts, electrical currents, vibrations, fumes, odors, dusts, gases, poor ventilation, chemicals, oils, extreme temperatures, inadequate lighting, work space restrictions, and travel.

Sedentary Work: Exerting up to 10 pounds of force occasionally and/or a negligible amount of force frequently or constantly to lift, carry, push, pull or otherwise move objects, including the human body. Sedentary work involves sitting most of the time. Jobs are sedentary if walking and standing are required only occasionally and all other sedentary criteria are met.
