

What are Prescription Opioids?

Narcotic pain medications that are prescribed for people with moderate to severe pain

Common Uses for Athletic Related Injuries:

Major Fractures & Post-Surgical Pain

Common Examples:

Oxycodone (Percocet, Roxicet), Hydrocodone (Vicodin, Norco), Propoxyphene (Darvon) Diphenoxylate, Codeine, Fentanyl, Hydromorphone (Dilaudid), Meperidine (Demerol), Methadone, Tramadol (Ultram)

Participation in athletics increases injury risk; therefore, high school athletes are more likely to be prescribed opioids then their peers.

LEARN THE 4 R's

RESPECT the power of medicine and use it properly

RECOGNIZE that all medicines, especially prescription medications have **RISKS** along with benefits

Take **RESPONSIBILITY** for learning how to take prescription medicines safely and appropriately

Signs/Symptoms of Opioid Use:

- Pinpoint pupils
- Flushing (redness) of face and neck
- Fatigue, red, glazed eyes
- Slurred speech
- Constipation

- Runny nose
- Dilated pupils
- Sudden trips to bathroom
- Severe insomnia

Signs/Symptoms of Opioid Withdrawal:

- Frequent yawning
