MCKINNEY-VENTO ACT

The McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act defines "homeless children and youths" as "individuals who lack a fixed, regular, and adequate nighttime residence." This includes:

- Living in a car, park or campsite
- Living in hotel/motel out of hardship
- Living in a shelter
- Double bunking for less than one year

It is important to Kyrene School District that we help each and every student to reach his or her highest potential. Unfortunately sometimes our students fall on hard times, which interferes with their schooling. SafeLink Wireless provides free cell phones and plans to low-income households through the federal Lifeline program if you receive one of the following programs:

- AHCCCS
- SNAP/Food Stamps
- KidsCare
- Federal Public Housing Assistance (Section 8)
- Supplemental Security Income
- Temporary Assistance to Needy Families
- Low-Income Home Energy Assistance

A SafeLink representative will be available during the hours listed to process enrollments and answer questions. You must bring:

- Photo ID
- Proof that you meet the above requirements by providing your program card or approval letter,
- Previous year Tax Returns or W-2 as proof of income or Social Security Award Letter. Households are eligible for ONE free phone TOTAL, regardless of provider.

Through LifeBridge, the Massachusetts Mutual Life Insurance Company (MassMutual) insures the lives of qualified working people for the benefit of their children. A 10-year term life insurance policy, with a death benefit of \$50,000, is provided.
