

# Altadena Boys Basketball

Welcome to a new season of boys basketball here at Altadena. We are truly looking forward to a fun and competitive season with this year's team. Below is some information that will help you understand a little more about the upcoming season.

**Required Steps for Tryouts- All three steps need to be completed by Thursday, November 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2022. Registration will close at 4pm on November 3<sup>rd</sup>, and not be reopened for any reasons.**

For athletes to be eligible and participate in tryouts, all of the following must be completed:

## **Try-Outs Dates and Times**

Tryouts will begin on Monday, November 7, beginning at 3:30pm until 5:00pm and will go through the end of the week. There will be no afternoon tryouts on Wednesday Nov. 9<sup>th</sup>. Its possible tryouts may go through Monday, November 14<sup>th</sup> depending on the number of boys trying out.

The boys will meet in the gym after school. Tryouts are considered closed to anyone not trying out, this includes parents and other students.

**All practices will be after school for both JV and V teams from 3:30pm-5:00pm**

Students and parents will be informed of any changes to the practice schedule at least a day before. All team members are expected to attend all practices and games, this includes being on time. If a student is not going to make a scheduled practice or game, an email or voicemail message will need to be left with Ms. Saccoman or the coach before the practice or game.

## **Season Schedule:**

The season schedule will be distributed to the students at the completion of tryouts. There will also be copies with Ms. Saccoman at the Student Services desk in the front office. Games will be Monday and Thursdays, with JV games beginning at 4:30pm followed immediately by Varsity at 5:30pm

## **Discipline Procedures:**

Whether in the classroom or on or off the court, the student is a representative of the team and Altadena and should conduct themselves accordingly.
