

Install Pulse to Connect to Kyrene Network Remotely

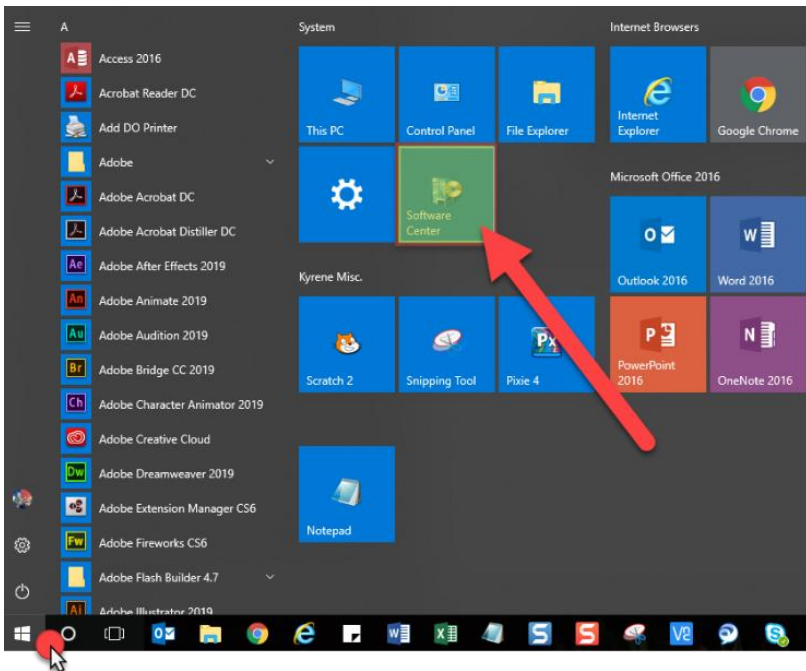
Junos Pulse is used to connect Kyrene laptops to the Kyrene network, while away from the office or school.

Follow the instructions to install Pulse so that you can connect to the Kyrene network each time you log on to the Internet from a Kyrene laptop while away from the office.

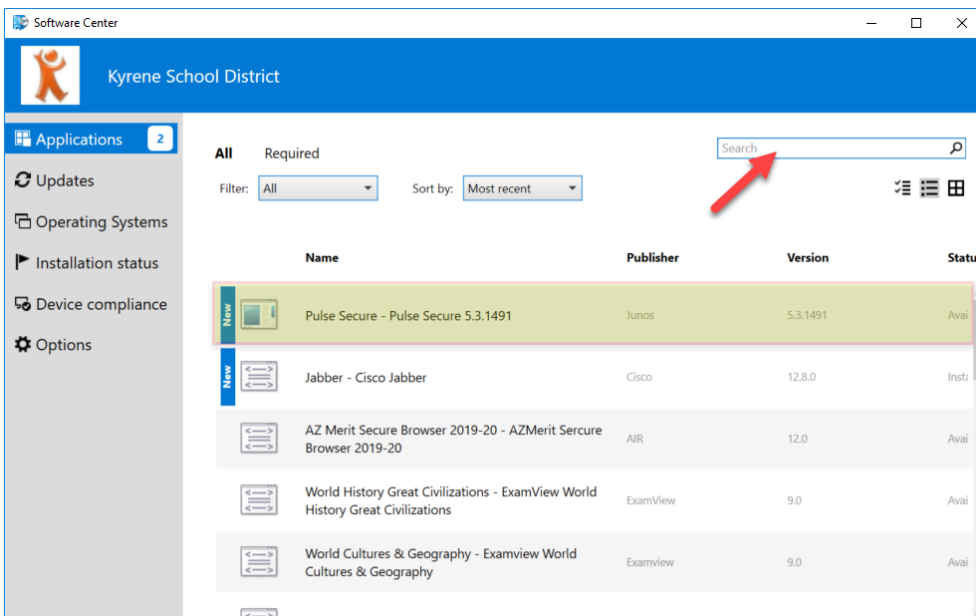
Install - IMPORTANT: Installation only needs to be done before going home if you are using a “student” laptop. All staff laptops (X1 and 260 models) already have Pulse installed by default.

For “student” laptops:

Navigate to Software Center. Click on Start Menu. Select Software Center. (If not there, begin typing “Software Center” and select.)

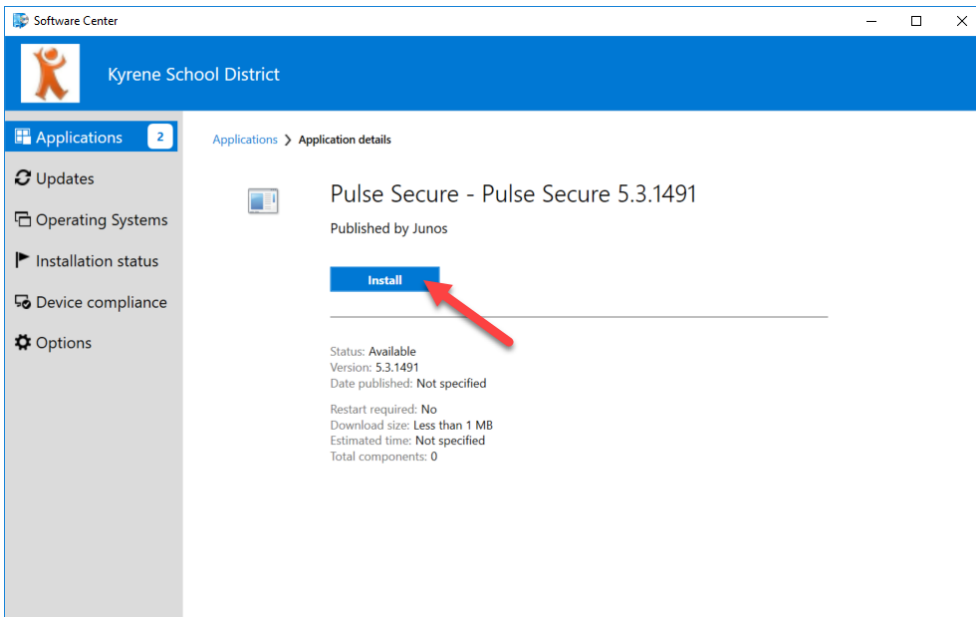



You should see Pulse on the home screen, but if it is not listed, use the search bar and search for “Pulse”

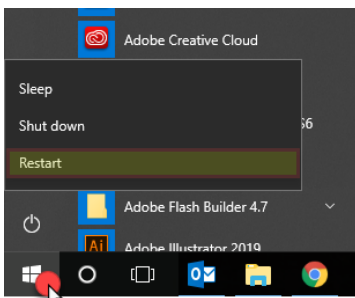


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Click on the software and select Install button.



Once you see the Pulse icon  in the system tray, click Start Menu and Restart PC.



Shut down PC before leaving the office.

For all laptops:

If Pulse is installed correctly, you will see the Pulse icon in the system tray at the bottom of your screen.



When you are at home, or away from the office:

NOTE: If you do not have Internet access at home or are at a location without Internet access, you will experience slowness when logging on. The screen may go black or appear to be unresponsive. Please be patient when the black screen appears. Do not shut down or restart. Your computer will log on and you will be able to access tools and files saved directly on that computer.

If you have Internet access at home but experience slowness and/or black screen, check to verify that your home Internet is working. Once your log on is complete, check for Internet connectivity. You may need to log off and log back on to connect to the Internet.

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Turn on laptop and log on.

The following screen may appear.


Enter your Kyrene username and password.

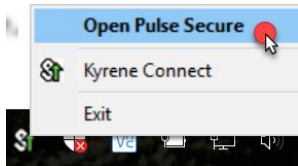
Check the **Save Settings** box to enable.

Click **Connect**.



Now you will be automatically connected to the Kyrene network upon log in.

To check your connection, you can click on the Pulse icon  in the system tray and select Open Pulse.



"Connected" will display under Kyrene Connect on the Pulse Secure screen.
