- (4) single subject spiral notebooks - one for each subject (Please do not buy one multi-subject notebook. The cheap single subject spiral notebooks work best.)
- (1) 3-prong Poly folder for ELA
- Pencil case with 3 holes
- Pencils - mechanical pencils are OK, but please have replacement lead
- Pencil sharpener - personal size
- Eraser
- 3 or 4 Colored pens for revising work and/or correcting classwork/homework (not black)
- Highlighters (blue, pink, yellow, orange and green)
- Dry erase markers
- Sticky notes
- Loose leaf lined paper - 100 sheets ONLY for the binder. Keep additional paper at home, please.
- Loose-leaf graph paper - 50 sheets ONLY for the binder. Keep additional paper at home, please.
