SCHOOL & OFFICE HOURS

The regular school day starts at **8:20** AM and ends (Mon/Tue/Thurs/Fri) at 3:05 PM and on Wednesdays at 1:05 PM. Students are allowed on campus any time after 7:50 AM when supervision begins. The first bell rings at 8:15 AM and students are considered tardy when the second bell rings at 8:20 AM. Our office hours are changing as well. On (Mon/Tue/Thurs/Fri) the school office will be open from 7:30 - 4:00 PM and open on Wednesdays at 7:30 - 2:00 PM.

STUDENTS ARE NOT ALLOWED ON CAMPUS UNTIL 7:50 AM

Please note, in accordance with the Kyrene Family Handbook and also to promote safe practices, students will not be allowed on campus until 30 minutes prior to the first bell (7:50 AM) and must leave immediately at the end of the school day. We do not have adults on school grounds to supervise students prior to 7:50 AM and after 3:05 PM.

The ParentVUE Mobile application helps parents stay informed and connected by providing day-to-day insight into their child's academic experience. ParentVUE Mobile for the iPhone/iPod Touch works with the Synergy™ student information system in much the same way as the ParentVUE web portal, allowing parents to access near real-time information on assignments and scores, attendance, and demographic

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT SCHOOL MEALS

Kyrene School District is excited and preparing for the 2023-2024 school year. The application portal for free and reduced lunch will open July 1, 2023. As a reminder, a new meal application is required every year to determine eligibility for the current school year. This message provides some key dates and important information pertaining to our Food Service program for the upcoming school year.

Key Dates:

July 1- Online Application portal opens! Apply for free or reduced lunch for the 2023-2024 school year. July 19- First day of school

August 30- Eligibility from 2022-2023 school year **EXPIRES!** Please <u>submit a new application</u> for the new school year starting July 1, 2023.

Exciting News!

The United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) has approved the Arizona Department of Education (ADE) to partner with the Arizona Health Care Cost Containment System (AHCCCS).

What does this mean for your family?

If your student(s) receives Medicaid or resides in a household with another child who receives Medicaid and has family income as measured by the Medicaid Program, your student(s) *may* be eligible to receive meals for free or at a reduced price.

Important Update for 2023-2024 School Year

Students who have completed a federal meal application and have been designated as reduced-priced eligible will be provided free breakfast and lunch meals through June 30, 2024 through Arizona Department of Education funds, or until the funds are exhausted.

Important take-aways and links:

- A new meal application is required every year to determine eligibility for the current school year.
- Meal Prices will remain the same, please click meal prices on our website for information.
- To submit your 2023-2024 household meal application, please click here starting July 1.
- Meal Account payments may be made online by clicking make a school lunch payment.
- Lunch balances may be viewed by visiting Linq Connect.
- Household meal applications for the 2023-2024 school year will not be accepted prior to July 1, 2023.
- Your household may be eligible for the Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP), please visit GetInternet.gov to check eligibility.

Are You Ready for 6th Grade? Are Your Child's Shots Up To Date?



AZ Administration Code requires certain immunizations for school entry/attendance

Please note the immunization requirements listed below:

Students 11 years of age and older are required to have had one dose of **Tdap** vaccine if 5 years have passed since their last dose of tetanus/diphtheria containing vaccine. Most children had their last DPT when they were 5 years old, so most 11 year old children will be due for a booster.

Students 11 years of age and older are required to have had one dose of **Meningococcal** vaccine (MV, MCV4, or Menactra)

These immunizations will be **due** by the **first day** of school, **August 15, 2023**, if your student will be 11 years old by that date.

Please review your child's immunizations with your health care provider. You can contact your school health office if you have any questions.
