NEW VOLUNTEER FINGERPRINTING PROCESS for 2019-2020 SCHOOL YEAR

Centennial Middle School is so appreciative of our family and community volunteers, as this adds value to students' learning experience. To ensure that this experience is as safe as possible, we want to make you aware of a change in practice when it comes to the fingerprinting process. Beginning in the 2019-2020 school year, all non-parent/guardians attending overnight field trips and all non-parent/guardian volunteers, will need to hold a valid state-issued Fingerprint Clearance Card (FPCC). Kyrene School District will no longer conduct fingerprinting process for volunteers.

A FPCC currently costs \$75 and can be obtained through a [Department of Public Safety](#) approved vendor. This process is typically much faster than fingerprinting by the District, and once obtained, a FPCC is valid for six years. This will eliminate the need for our volunteers to be fingerprinted each year. We recommend families obtain cards over the summer. FPCC requirements are rooted in child safety. Thank you for your support as we put students first.

IMPORTANT REMINDER ABOUT CENTENNIAL DRESS CODE POLICY

Warm weather is here! Please go over dress code policy with your student (s). In addition to items below, we are seeing many students wearing torn jeans. In the event that a student has torn jeans above the knee, students will be dress coded. Torn jeans showing any bare skin **ABOVE** the knee is a violation of the CMS dress code. Thank you for sharing dress code policy with your student.

	Bottoms	Tops
Boys	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must cover undergarments and buttocks at all times. • Pants/shorts must be worn at the waist band and not below the waist (no sagging). • No ripped jeans/shorts that show bare skin. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hemmed, sleeveless shirts are permitted. • Tank tops, without wide sleeves are permitted. (Chest cannot be showing)
Girls	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shorts and skirts must have at least a 4 inch inseam and/or at the mid thigh length. • No ripped jeans/shorts that show bare skin. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No spaghetti straps or strapless tops. • Tank tops are permitted, but only if undergarments (bras and camis) are fully covered and not going to show. • Shirts/Tank Tops must cover chest, stomach, back at all times. (No mid drifts showing, no cleavage and no cut out backs.)
