DELIVERING MESSAGES, DROPPED OFF ITEMS & END OF DAY SIGN-OUTS

As a **Leader in Me School, Habit 2 - Begin with the End in Mind** asks our students to plan for their day. This includes having their lunch/money, homework, signed permission slips, etc. To help students practice Habit 2, we will no longer be calling students to pick up items delivered. If your child is aware that an item is in the office, they are welcome to come and pick it up in the front office. While it is understandable that students will forget things, we ask that you make an effort to ensure that your child is responsible and prepared before coming to school.

Except in emergency situations, parents/guardians should avoid calling the school to leave a message for their student. When unavoidable, a message will be taken, and office staff will communicate the message to your student's teachers. We no longer can accommodate any emergency requests to deliver messages to students after 2:50 PM, or 12:50pm on Wednesday. Thank you so much for your cooperation.

ATTENDANCE LINE

Pueblo Middle School is equipped with a computerized telephone attendance reporting system.

The absence reporting phone number is 480-541-6801 and may be called 24 hours a day.

Parents/guardians are asked to call the attendance office by 9:00 AM each day that their child is absent. Please leave a message on the voice mail indicating the student's name, grade, date(s) of the absence and reason for the absence. If we do not receive a parent phone call, the student's absence will be recorded as a truancy.

Pueblo Absence Reporting and Tardy Policy

NOTE: Parents MUST call the attendance line within 24 hours of an absence, even if they spoke to the health office, or if they told a teacher, we cannot excuse any absences until we receive a message from the parent/guardian.

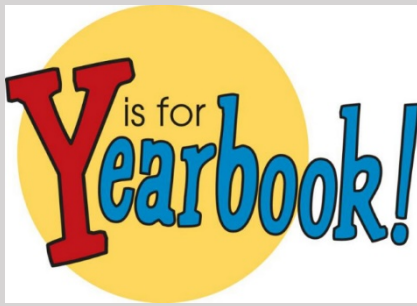
STUDENT ACTIVITIES

ATTENTION 6TH GRADE PARENTS

Are your child's shots up to date?

AZ Administration Code requires certain immunizations for school entry/attendance.

Please note the immunization requirements listed below:

- Students **11 years of age** and older are required to have one dose of Tdap vaccine if 5 years have passed since their last dose of tetanus/diphtheria containing vaccine. Most children had their last DPT when they were 5 years old, so most 11 year old children will be due for a booster.

- Students **11 years of age** and older are required to have one dose of Meningococcal vaccine (MV, MCV4, or Menactra).
- These immunizations were due by the first day of school, July 29th, 2022 if your student was 11 years old by that date. Otherwise, they are due within 14 days of your students' 11th birthday.

Please review your child's immunizations with your health care provider.

*When your child receives the necessary immunizations **please bring a copy of the record to the front office or email the health office: dnavarro@kyrene.org or mwstawiecki@kyrene.org**. The record must show the child's name, date of birth, the month, day and year that the shot(s) were given and the name of the clinic or physician that administered the vaccine.*
