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Bulldog Families,

Our school is continuing to implement a whole-school transformational process called the *Leader in Me*, which teaches 21st-century leadership and life skills to students and creates a culture of student empowerment based on the idea that every child can be a leader. Starting November 4, 2022 our school will be conducting surveys to learn more about key areas of strength and areas of needed growth in our school. The data from these surveys will also help us track the impacts of the Leader in Me process and implement key practices more fully. In order for us to have a holistic picture of what is going on in our school, we are asking all staff members, parents/guardians, and students to participate. Below is additional information about the process and the content of the surveys.

**Parent Participation** - If you decide to participate, you will be asked to complete a survey (without sharing your name or other identifying information) that will be available through a Web link we will send out next Friday, November 4. The survey is completely voluntary, but we do hope to get feedback from one member of every household. The survey should take about 12 minutes to complete. If you have more than one child at Pueblo, you will be asked to think about the oldest child's experiences as you answer the questions related to his or her growth.

**Student Participation** - If your child decides to participate, he or she will be asked to complete a 20-minute multiple choice assessment (no identifying information will be requested or collected) that will be confidentially administered by their advisory teacher. Students will privately answer questions about their attitudes and behaviors on a computer at school. They will be able to skip questions and stop at any time they choose. Students who do not wish to participate in the survey or stop participating, or whose parents choose to deny participation for their participation, will be provided with an appropriate alternate activity while the survey is being conducted. If you indicated that you did not want your child to participate in social emotional learning surveys, they will not participate in the *Leader in Me* survey.

Pueblo Bulldogs earned \$11,580 and had 635 donations! Also, 272 students participated in the Day of Awesomeness.



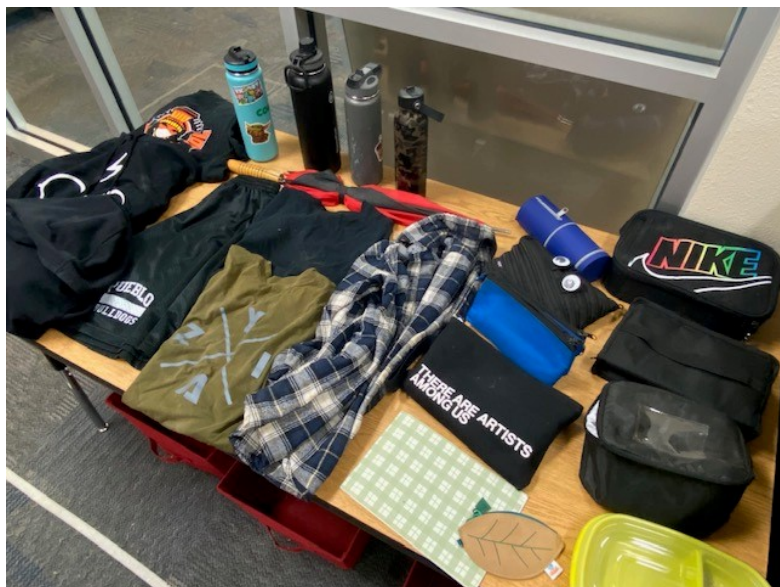
## 7 HABITS AT HOME

How did being proactive help me this week?

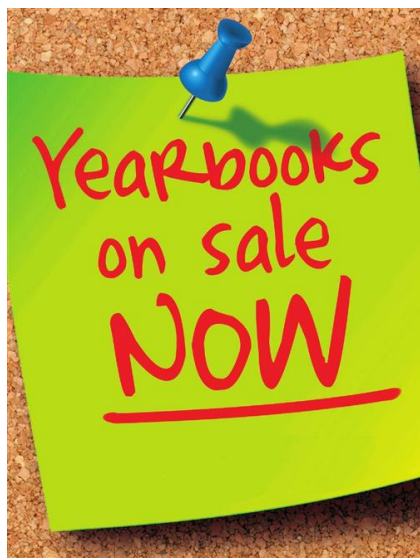
What are some goals you have to be more proactive at home?

### **ATTENDANCE LINE**

Pueblo Middle School is equipped with a computerized telephone attendance reporting system.

The absence reporting phone number is 480-541-6801 and may be called 24 hours a day.

*Parents/guardians are asked to call the attendance office by 9:00 AM each day that their child is absent. Please leave a message on the voice mail indicating the student's name, grade, date(s) of the absence and reason for the absence. If we do not receive a parent phone call, the student's absence will be recorded as a truancy.*

### **Pueblo Absence Reporting and Tardy Policy**

*NOTE: Parents MUST call the attendance line within 24 hours of an absence, even if they spoke to the health office, or if they told a teacher, we cannot excuse any absences until we receive a message from the parent/guardian.*

## MEAL DELIVERIES

Please note that we do not allow any third party lunch deliveries to the school office. Examples would include Door Dash and Uber Eats, among others. Deliveries of this kind disrupt students' lunch schedules and the timing is often unreliable. In addition we have a food service contract with the District which specifies not having competing foods brought into school. Parents may bring their own students' lunches to the office if need be, but may not bring lunches or treats for additional students. Going forward, if any 3rd party delivered lunches arrive in the office, unless arrangements have been previously made with the health office, the student will have to pick it up at the end of the day. Your cooperation is appreciated.

## DELIVERING MESSAGES, DROPPED OFF ITEMS & END OF DAY SIGN-OUTS

As a **Leader in Me School**, **Habit 2 - Begin with the End in Mind** asks our students to plan for their day. This includes having their lunch/money, homework, signed permission slips, etc. To help students practice Habit 2, we will no longer be calling students to pick up items delivered. If your child is aware that an item is in the office, they are welcome to come and pick up in the front office. While it is understandable that students will forget things, we ask that you make an effort to ensure that your child is responsible and prepared before coming to school.

Except in emergency situations, parents/guardians should avoid calling the school to leave a message for their student. When unavoidable, a message will be taken, and office staff will communicate the message to your student's teachers. We no longer can accommodate any emergency requests to deliver messages to students after 2:50 PM, or 12:50pm on Wednesday. Thank you so much for your cooperation.

***IMPORTANT: In the event of an emergency, text messages are the fastest and most effective way to communicate information to families. You must opt in to receive text communications!
