MEET THE TEACHER

This event will take place on Monday, July 17 with gates opening at 12:50 pm.

- 6th grade students and families will visit classrooms at Pueblo from 1:00 - 2:20
- 7th and 8th grade families will come to Pueblo from 2:40 - 4:00

We are encouraging students and parents to access schedules in advance through ParentVue. These will be available on Monday, July 17 at approximately 10:00 AM. *In an effort to save*

paper and reduce crowding, we WILL NOT be passing out paper copies of student schedules.

Please consider adding the [ParentVUE](#) mobile app to your phone for easy access. If for some reason you cannot access your child's schedule through [ParentVUE](#) please contact the Pueblo front office at 480-541-6800, during our [posted office hours](#).

Students will be following their schedules and meeting teachers during designated times. We will be providing event schedules and map hand-outs at the event. It is important that we stick to the schedule to keep everything running on time and to avoid overcrowding. During the lunch period on your schedule, please stop by the MPR to purchase a Pueblo spirit shirt, learn about athletics and lunch account information.

This is not an open-house event and we appreciate your help with not congregating and socializing inside the classrooms. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.

Schedule changes will only be considered in cases where a student is scheduled into a class that is the wrong level or is missing a class. We will have a schedule correction form available for parents to submit if this is the case.

WEB - 6th GRADE ORIENTATION

On July 17 our 6th grade Bulldogs are invited to come to Pueblo to meet their WEB leaders and some of our teachers and administrators. WEB, which stands for Where Everybody Belongs, is a nationally recognized middle school orientation, transition, and mentoring program. WEB involves 8th grade students being trained as leaders and mentors to help welcome and develop positive friendships with our new 6th grade students. STUDENT DROP-OFF & PICK-UP PROCEDURES

If you plan on dropping off or picking up your child from Pueblo you will use the front office parking lot. Students should not be dropped before 7:50 am, as there is no supervision before that time. Please pull all the way forward and drop your child off at the end of the parking lot. In order to keep things moving, have your child gather their supplies and say their goodbyes quickly when you are dropping off. We appreciate your help with keeping the line moving as fast as possible.

When picking your child up, please follow the same procedure and pull all the way forward to the end of the parking lot. Once your child is in the car you can move into the passing middle lane and exit the parking lot, allowing other cars to pull forward. The beginning of the school year is always busy during these times as everyone is figuring out the process and routines. Thank you in advance for your patience.

Please note the signs on Twelve Oaks Blvd. which indicate that there should be no stopping or parking during school hours and remember it is unsafe to make U-turns in a school zone.

ATTENDANCE LINE

Pueblo Middle School is equipped with a computerized telephone attendance reporting system.

The absence reporting phone number is 480-541-6801 and may be called 24 hours a day.

Parents/guardians are asked to call the attendance office by 9:00 AM each day that their child is absent. Please leave a message on the voice mail indicating the student's name, grade, date(s) of the absence and reason for the absence. If we do not receive a parent phone call, the student's absence will be recorded as a truancy.

Pueblo Absence Reporting and Tardy Policy

NOTE: Parents MUST call the attendance line within 24 hours of an absence, even if they spoke to the health office, or if they told a teacher, we cannot excuse any absences until we receive a message from the parent/guardian.

TEXT MESSAGE COMMUNICATIONS

Families are encouraged to opt in for our Kyrene School District and school based text message for reminders and notifications. You can sign up to receive text message alerts by texting "Y" or "yes" to 67587. This is something that needs to be done every year.

ParentVUE MOBILE APP & ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

The ParentVUE Mobile application helps parents stay informed and connected by providing day-to-day insight into their child's academic experience. ParentVUE Mobile for the iPhone/iPod Touch works with the Synergy™ student information system in much the same way as the ParentVUE web portal, allowing parents to access near real-time information on assignments and scores, attendance, and demographic information. PBIS DONATIONS

Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports (PBIS) is a school-wide process for creating positive and safe environments that are predictable, encouraging, and effective for achieving academic success and reaching social goals.

Here at Pueblo Middle School, we focus our efforts on helping all children exceed their potential by teaching to and supporting the whole child. We believe in our students and recognize that they are simply fantastic with the majority of students following our school expectations. When they do this, we want to recognize these positive behaviors by issuing students “Dawg Tags”.

PBIS helps us as staff acknowledge our students’ efforts daily as they demonstrate their best. Through instruction, comprehension and regular practice, all teachers, staff members, and students use and follow a consistent set of behavior expectations and routines across all school settings. All students are directly and explicitly taught school expectations throughout the school year to continually ensure understanding. At times, students may make choices that are not positive. When this happens, we view it as an opportunity for re-teaching.

We have adopted a unified set of expectations in all common areas which you will see posted throughout the school. Students are recognized daily with online “Dawg Tags” for practicing the

Students will have the opportunity to earn dawg tags when they are “caught” demonstrating appropriate behavior. These can be cashed in for prizes and snacks every Wednesday at the PBIS cart during lunch. We are asking for donations to help stock our PBIS store. Items such as
