Updating Address and/or Emergency Contacts: Every family is asked at the beginning of the year to go to their ParentVUE account and review their address, emergency contacts and other demographic information to be sure the student system is kept current. Please login to ParentVUE and choose the "Health, Emergency & Address Information Update" packet to review your student's information and update as necessary.

Reporting Absences: All student absences must be reported to the Attendance Line within the first 2 hours of the school day. To report an absence please call 480.541.5201. This is a 24 hour/per day attendance line. If your student will be late to school please call the attendance line or call the office at 480.541.5200. Absences reported to the teacher are helpful, however to have an excused absence, it must be reported to the office or attendance line. If you child is not called out of school an unexcused absence or truancy will be applied.

Absent from After School Programs: If your student will not be attending their after school program or enrichment class please make sure to notify the program, teacher and school office. The office is the first place that the after school programs check with if they are missing a student.

Change The Way Your Student Goes Home: If there is a change in the way your student will go home on the same day, please email the classroom teacher before 10:30am. If after 10:30am please call the office, 480.541.5200. Teachers may not see emails from parents later in the day.

Lost and Found: Please make sure all lunch boxes, water bottles, jackets, sweaters and sweatshirts are labeled with your child's name so they can be returned. Our Lost and Found overflows at the end of each quarter and items not claimed are donated to the Kyrene Family Resource Center.

Stay Informed Via Test Messages: If you care to receive text messages from Sierra and Kyrene School District, please opt in by texting "Y' or "Yes" to 67587. See the Communications and Engagement website for more information regarding email and text message communication.

Curriculum Nights: Our annual Curriculum Nights are next week on August 8 and August 10. Please see the attached <u>flyer</u> for grade level specific dates and times. As a reminder, this event is for parents/guardians only and we respectfully ask that you prearrange child care.

Morning Drop-Off and Afternoon Pick-Up Procedures: Please take time to review our current Morning Drop-Off and Afternoon Pick-Up Procedures.

- If you are walking your child to/from school please utilize the marked crosswalks and refrain from crossing mid-way. It may take a few extra minutes but our crossing guards are there to ensure that you and your child make it safely across the street.
- When entering our parking lots please pull as far forward as you can and stay in your car. This will allow for vehicles behind you to pull in and decrease the traffic in the street. Please DO NOT let your child out in the street. If you prefer to stay away from the parking lot, the bus bay is available, after the buses leave, for you to pull in to and drop your student off.
- If you choose to pull in and park, please note that there are several spots that are designated for Preschool parking only. Please respect these spots and refrain from using them if you do not have preschoolers.
- The current procedure for afternoon pick-up is as follows (this will be for as long as we have heat advisories), all bus-riders are released at the bell to board the school bus, all walkers, bike riders and parent pick-up walk-ups or those that are meeting their parents on the grass are released at the bell and all parent pick-up car-line pick ups are released when their name is called by the staff on duty. Please help us by communicating the preferred pick-up method for your child to the classroom teacher. If you are in the car-line please leave your sign in the car window until your child has entered your vehicle. This will help us expedite the process and get your student to you quickly.
- If you park and walk to pick-up your child after school DO NOT PARK IN CROSSWALK
 ZONES. Vehicles parking between the posted no parking/stopping signs are in violation of
 standard school traffic zone laws and are subject to fines. Please know that the safety of your
 student is of the utmost importance and crossing guards are there to guide families safely
 across the street.


