How can I help my child?

In our small groups, we are practising identifying our Zones of Regulation and naming our feelings. Have your child practice naming how they are feeling and what zone that feeling might be in.

Blue Zone: brain and body are moving slow. Ex: Sad, bored, tired

Green Zone: Our brain is clear and we are ready to learn. Ex: happy, calm, peaceful

Yellow Zone: Body and brain are uncomfortable, emotions slightly elevated. Ex: Frustrated, silly, worried

Red Zone: brain and body are out of control. Ex: Angry, mean, yelling, hitting

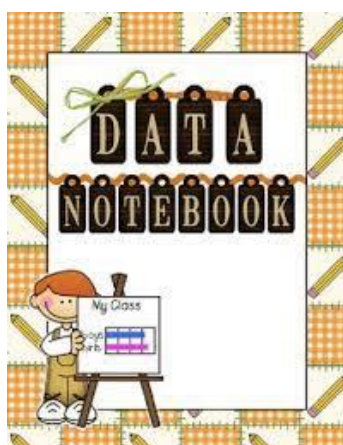

Kyrene de las Lomas Elementary Data Notebooks Implementation



Academic achievement is a priority at Lomas. A part of our vision is to empower our scholars to embrace their voice, own their learning, and track their learning progress. So, we are excited to announce the implementation of the Lomas Data Notebook (LDN). These binders will help your child keep track of several parts of their academic learning. iReady minutes, iReady lessons, DIBELS progress, Math and ELA assessments will be recorded each week. The LDN will be sent home every two weeks for you to celebrate and discuss with your scholar(s). You will have the opportunity to sign the parent signature page and then return the notebook the following Monday, so scholars can keep tracking their progress.

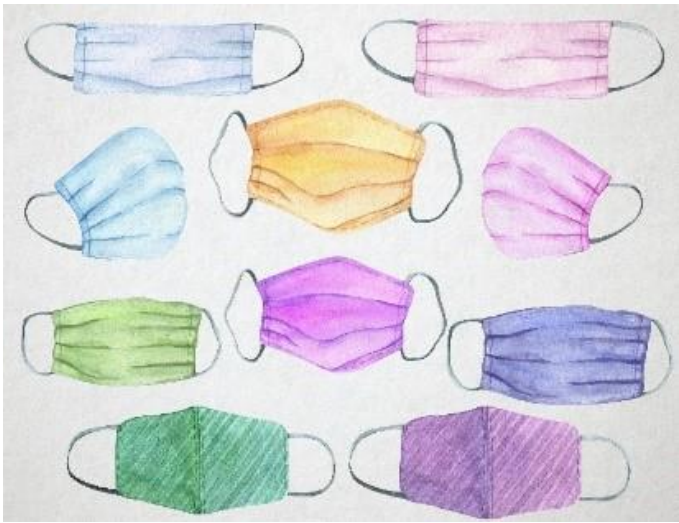


Clothes for health office

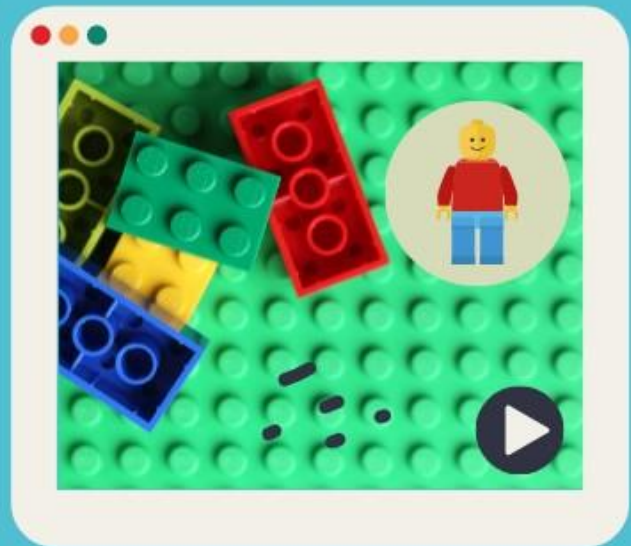

The Kyrene School District is partnering with Native Health to provide COVID-19 vaccinations for the entire Kyrene Community (staff, students, families). This vaccination clinic will be held in the Ninos MPR room on September 1, 22, and October 13 from 3:00-6:00 p.m. The first dose of the Pfizer vaccine will be available September 1 and 22 and the 2nd dose will be given on September 22 or October 13.. The vaccine is available to **ALL** Kyrene staff, families and students 12 years and older.

If you are experiencing any symptoms associated with COVID-19, you must meet the three criteria to return to school/work.

FEVER FREE FOR 24 HOURS*
SYMPTOMS IMPROVING
NEGATIVE COVID-19 TEST

*without the use of fever-reducing medication

You must meet ALL THREE of the above conditions or stay home from school/work for 10 days after the onset of symptoms.
