Registration for the 2022-23 school year begins January 11, 2022.

Kindergarten Enrollment Begins January 11th



Dear Kyrene Preschool Family,

Kyrene School District is proud to be part of your child's earliest learning experience. Our preschools are designed to ensure students enter kindergarten ready to learn. Your child appears to be entering kindergarten next year, and enrollment begins next week! Registration will open Tuesday, January 11 for the 2022-23 school year.

To help support your child's registration, you are receiving this letter with instructions tailored specifically for you, based on your child's current Kyrene preschool program.

Children enrolled in a Community or Signature Preschool:

If you have no other children currently or previously enrolled in Kyrene, and you have no children in an Integrated Preschool program in Kyrene, you will access the <u>new family portal</u> and create a new account to begin registration. Once in the portal, be sure to select 2022-2023 New Student, Registration from the dropdown menu.

If you have older children currently or previously enrolled in Kyrene, you will follow the instructions below to begin your preschool child's kindergarten enrollment.

Children enrolled in Integrated Preschool / Preschool families with older children who currently or previously attended Kyrene schools:

You must register your new kindergartener through your existing ParentVUE account.

Families who have/had a child enrolled in Kyrene but have not set-up a ParentVUE account should have received an email with an activation code. If you did not receive this code, call your school's front office. They will confirm your email address and provide a code to get you started.

Once in ParentVUE, select the "online registration" link (in the top right corner), select 2022-2023 Current Student, Change School Request from the drop-down menu.

Note: If you currently have other children in grades K-8, you will see them listed in your ParentVUE account. Select **exclude** and move forward with your Kindergartener.

Thank you for taking the time to register your child(ren). We look forward to seeing your preschoolers in kindergarten next year!





Gifted Testing 2021-22

All public school districts have an ongoing "Child Find" obligation. This means that the Kyrene School District will identify, locate and evaluate all children within their geographic boundaries who are in need of special education and related services. Kyrene makes gifted testing available for students at school sites three times per year by application. Applications are due for the next round of testing for 2021-22 on January 17, 2022. Tax Credit Donations



This giving season, please consider making a tax credit donation to a Kyrene school. Arizona tax payers can receive a dollar-for-dollar tax credit when they contribute to extracurricular activities in public schools. Tax credit donations help students attend activities like athletics; art and music programs; character education; and field trips...anything that requires enrolled students to pay a fee to participate. When you make a tax credit donation, you can reduce the amount of taxes you owe to the State of Arizona. The amount you contribute (up to \$200 for single taxpayers or \$400 for married couples filing jointly) will be the amount you may claim as a state tax credit.
