During the week of February 8th, teachers will individually assist students in putting their elective course requests into

StudentVUE. Parents will verify these requests in [ParentVUE](#) the following week. Below is the timeline of these important dates for reference:

- 2/2/2021 - 2/8/2021: Families and students will review the 7th/8th Grade Elective Interest Sheet to identify the elective courses they would like next year
- 2/8/2021 - 2/12/2021: 6th and 7th grade teachers will meet with individual students to input their elective course requests for next school year
- 2/18/2021 - 2/19/2021: 6th and 7th grade parents will confirm their child's elective classes in ParentVUE (directions to come later)

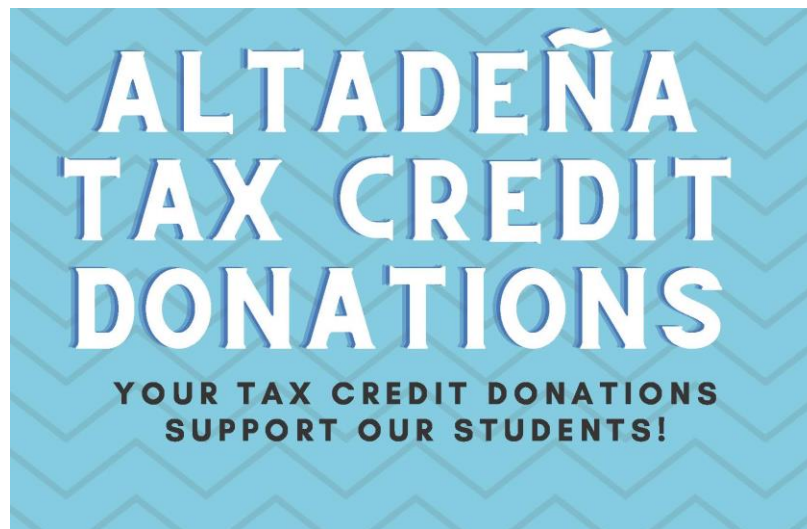

Donations made between January 1 through April 15 of the calendar year may be used as a tax credit on your prior year's tax return. You'll receive a dollar-for-dollar tax credit for qualifying donations - up to \$200 per individual and \$400 per couple.

To make an online tax credit donation:

1. Go to [Donate Online Now](#) on the Kyrene website.
2. In the lower half of the page, click on MAKE A ONE TIME DONATION.
3. Make sure you choose Kyrene Altadeña under the school section.
4. You can direct your donation to a specific program under the Item tab or choose General.
5. Fill in the amount you are donating and click Buy.
6. Click Check out.
7. After you have completed your transaction, you will receive a confirmation receipt in your email that can use for tax purposes.
