

Donations made between January 1 through April 15 of the calendar year may be used as a tax credit on your prior year's tax return. You'll receive a dollar-for-dollar tax credit for qualifying donations - up to \$200 per individual and \$400 per couple.

To make an online tax credit donation:

- 1. Go to **Donate Online Now** on the Kyrene website.
- 2. In the lower half of the page, click on MAKE A ONE TIME DONATION.
- 3. Make sure you choose Kyrene Altadeña under the school section.
- 4. You can direct your donation to a specific program under the Item tab or choose General.
- 5. Fill in the amount you are donating and click Buy.
- 6. Click Check out.
- 7. After you have completed your transaction, you will receive a confirmation receipt in your email that can use for tax purposes.
