Inside the Classroom:

This week I would like to share some highlights from our 8th grade classrooms. Students in Ms. Willever's class learned how to compose a strong literature analysis that includes quotes from text to support their claim. Spanish 2 students continued to develop their listening comprehension skills by watching short stories in Spanish. Both Ms. Rodriguez and Ms. Harris had students work on DBQ's. You may be asking, what is a DBQ? DBQ is short for Document-Based Question. Social Studies teachers utilize DBQ's as a way to prepare students for the high school AP test and college. In a DBQ students are required to craft a thesis and support it with textual based evidence from short historical documents or quotes.

EARLY STUDENT PICKUP- If parents are picking up your student early for any reason, please send a note with your student to bring to the office at the start of the school day. Office staff will issue your student a pass to leave class at the designated time. This will result in minimal calls to the classrooms interrupting instruction as well as having your student meet you in the office in a timely manner for sign out.

PARKING REMINDERS-Please adhere to the "No Parking" signs in the Thistle Landing neighborhood across from Altadeña's campus. There is no parking or waiting to drop off/pick up students permitted on Thistle Landing and adjacent streets. Parking is only permitted for residents of that neighborhood. Please use the Altadeña parking lot drop off/pick up designated areas only.


