**MASK MANDATE-** Face coverings are required for all individuals indoors, regardless of vaccination status. This includes staff, students and visitors. Face coverings continue to be required on District transportation, per Federal order. We have distributed a few thousand masks to students since the beginning of the school year and our supply is depleted. Our district warehouse has masks on back order. Please provide your student with a mask from home to start each school day.

**EARLY STUDENT PICKUP-** If parents are picking up your student early for any reason, please send a note with your student to bring to the office at the start of the school day. Office staff will issue your student a pass to leave class at the designated time. This will result in minimal calls to the classrooms interrupting instruction as well as having your student meet you in the office in a timely manner for sign out.

SIGN UP TO RECEIVE TEXT REMINDERS- Families must elect to receive text communications. Text “Y” or “yes” to 67587 to begin receiving text messages from both your child’s school and the Kyrene School District.

24 HR ATTENDANCE LINE- Parents are required to notify the school when your child is absent or running late. You do this by calling our 24-hour attendance/tardy line at (480) 541-6001. Please make sure to call the attendance line and leave a message, and not the front office main line. If your child is late, please walk them into the Front Office and sign them in.

- FEVER FREE FOR 24 HOURS\***
- SYMPTOMS IMPROVING**
- NEGATIVE COVID-19 TEST**

\*without the use of fever-reducing medication

You must meet ALL THREE of the above conditions or stay home from school/work for 10 days after the onset of symptoms.

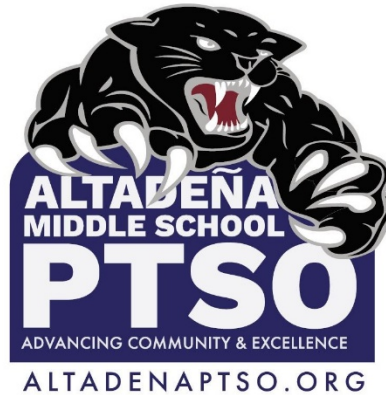
