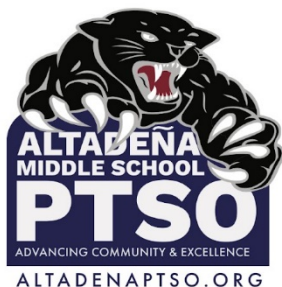

While in ParentVUE, please update emergency cards and contact phone numbers.



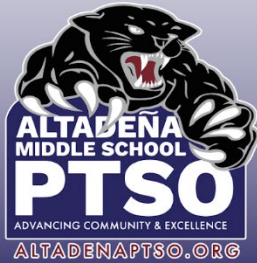
