Meet the Teacher

Meet the Teacher will look a little different this year, due to the earlier school start date. For Middle Schools, this will be held on Monday, July 17 from 1:00 - 4:00 pm. During Meet the Teacher families and students will follow the student's daily schedule starting with their advisory class. During each period, your child's teacher will have a short presentation specific to their class, before transitioning to the next period. It is important the schedule is followed in order to limit the number of individuals in any one area at a time. Since this is not an open-house event, we appreciate your help with not congregating and socializing inside the classrooms.

Gates will open at 12:45 PM with the first session beginning at 1:00 PM. As previously shared, students will first go to their Advisory teacher for a presentation about Altadeña and to learn more about their advisory period and school specific updates. The school bells will signal for families to transition to the next class for another curriculum presentation and to meet the next teacher. When families reach their student's lunch hour, families are welcome to visit the PTSO table, Panther athletics table, or our general inquiries table, located in the gym lobby and multi-purpose room.

We are encouraging students and parents to access schedules in advance through StudentVue and/or ParentVue. Student schedules will be available on Monday, July 17, after 10:00 AM. In an effort to save paper and reduce crowding, we will not be passing out paper copies of student schedules. Please consider adding the ParentVUE mobile app to your phone for easy access. If for some reason you cannot access your child's schedule through ParentVUE or StudentVUE please contact the Altadeña front office at 480-541-6000.

Families with students who are new to Kyrene this year will not have access to ParentVUE for their students until the first day of school. Office staff will be in the Multipurpose Room during Meet the Teacher to assist new families with accessing their student's schedule.

Schedule changes will only be considered in cases where a student is scheduled into a class that is the wrong level or missing a class. We will have schedule correction forms available for parents to submit if this is the case.

ParentVUE Mobile App

The ParentVUE Mobile application helps parents stay informed and connected by providing day-to-day insight into their child's academic experience. ParentVUE Mobile for the iPhone/iPod Touch works with the Synergy™ student information system in much the same way as the ParentVUE web portal, allowing parents to access near real-time information on assignments and scores, attendance, and demographic information. ParentVUE offers parents a single sign-on to view all of their children's information regardless of school. Go to ParentVUE Mobile App for directions and login.

Important: Sign up for Text Messages

In the event of an emergency, text messages are the fastest and most effective way to communicate information to families. You must opt in to receive text communications! Text "Y" or "yes" to 67587 to begin receiving text messages from our school and Kyrene School District.

Meet the Teacher Parking

Families are welcome to park in the lower parking lot or the upper parking lot, as well as the upper field. Community volunteers have generously agreed to assist with parking on the field. To access the fields please enter the upper parking lot, enter the open fire gate by the tennis courts/bike rack and follow the fire lane towards the basketball fields. We ask for everyone's patience as numerous families are arriving simultaneously. We kindly ask that families do not park directly on Desert Foothills Parkway or in the neighborhoods adjacent to Altadeña. Carpooling would greatly assist in reducing traffic.

Athletics/Clubs

Additional supplies may be requested throughout the school year and specifically for some of our elective classes. Thank you for helping to prepare your child for school. Always welcome are donations of boxes of facial tissue and printer/copier paper.

PBIS Donations

Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports is a school-wide process for creating positive and safe environments that are predictable, encouraging, and effective for achieving academic success and reaching social goals. Here at Altadeña Middle School, we focus our efforts on helping all children exceed their potential by teaching to and supporting the whole child.

Our students are simply terrific, and the majority of students follow our school expectations, and we want to recognize these positive behaviors. PBIS acknowledges their efforts daily as they demonstrate their best. Through instruction, comprehension and regular practice, all teachers, staff members, and students use and follow a consistent set of behavior expectations and routines across all school settings. All students are directly and explicitly taught school expectations throughout the school year to continually ensure understanding. At times, students make choices that are not positive. When this happens, we view it as an opportunity for re-teaching.

We have adopted a unified set of procedures expected in all common areas. You will see expectations posted throughout the school. Students are recognized daily for practicing:

Leadership Excellence Accountability Determination

This parking map has been discussed with District Transportation and for SAFETY PURPOSES, please follow all directions.

The upper parking lot is for buses ONLY. Once school starts, band and orchestra will provide parking passes for those students with large instruments.

The lower parking lot is for parent drop/pick-up. It is important to keep the flow of traffic going. When possible, please pull up as far as you can go. Parking will only be allowed to visitors coming to the office. Students WILL NOT be allowed to enter the parking lot to go to a parked car unless escorted by an adult.

Parking in Cerrito's parking lot is **DISCOURAGED**. There is not adult supervision there.
