Message from the Principal

Dear Altadeña Families,

Thank you for your patience with pick up and drop off delays during these first few days of school. Many of you have expressed concern about the time it is taking to move traffic before and after school under the current system, and I share those concerns as well. Beginning Monday, we will be making adjustments that should improve the flow of traffic during pick up and drop off.

The Altadeña team and I worked closely with Kyrene Transportation and District leadership to identify a solution that is more efficient but still safe for students and compliant with Arizona Department of Public Safety standards.

- Starting Monday we will be having parent pick-up and drop off be from the Altadena upper *and* lower lots. (See maps below.)
- Buses will also be utilizing the upper lot in the parking area that is closest to Desert Foothills Pkwy.
- Students arriving and departing from the school via school buses will be utilizing a new cross walk area that uses the upper lot exit, closest to Desert Foothills Pkwy.
- When bus students are using this area to cross, a staff member will be stopping onsite upper lot traffic in order to allow the safe crossing of those students.
- Please do not block the upper lot exit. This will prevent buses and parents from exiting, thus slowing the flow of traffic.
- Parking is available in both the upper and lower-level lots but will be limited in the upper lot due to the staging of the buses.

Please remember to take turns and allow the left hand turn of cars approaching from Chandler Blvd turning into the lower lot.

Much time and expertise go into traffic planning, and I appreciate the willingness of Kyrene's Transportation and District teams returning to the table to come up with an improved solution for our Altadeña community that is more efficient but still safe for our students and their families.


As we utilize this new system, it is important for parents/guardians to talk to students about pedestrian and traffic safety (for example—not crossing in front of cars, not getting into or out of cars on Desert Foothills Parkway, utilizing crosswalks). Your children's safety is of the utmost importance to me and everyone on our Altadeña team. Thank you for your partnership in keeping students safe and ensuring this new procedure is a success.

Staff Spotlight


