Cross Country

Last weekend the Altadeña CC team played host to the Pueblo Bulldogs, Aprende Jaguars, and the Kyrene Traditional Academy Tigers. Both Altadeña boys and girls came out on top. Boys scored 31 points with Ryan J. coming in first with a time of 8:45.1 and Carter F. second with a time of 9:14.8. Girls scored 16 points with Fiona P. coming in first with a time of 9:57.7, Kendyl T. in second at 10:12.5, Bailey O. in third at 10:19.4, and Jocelyn P. fourth in 10:20.5. All runners did a great job on a difficult 1.5-mile course. Altadeña heads to Pueblo this Saturday.

Girls Volleyball

JV Girls Volleyball opened their season on Monday night with a win against Pueblo Middle School, defeating their opponents 25 to 7 in the first match and 25-8 in the second. It was a balanced effort from the Panthers as they relied on their strong serving to carry them to victory.

Girls Varsity Volleyball started the season on Monday night with the Panthers on the road to take on the Pueblo Bulldogs. The Varsity girls team came away victorious, winning in two sets, but not without difficulty. They got off to a shaky start battling back and forth

with the Bulldogs in the game one but eventually pulled away and won 25-16. Game 2 was a battle of wits. The Panthers were sluggish and allowed the Bulldogs to take an 11-6 lead, but the Panthers did not give up. Pueblo continued to lead 18-14, but a couple of good serves from Piper G. pulled the Panthers to an 18-18 tie. Mia M. had a huge block that helped the Panthers take the lead and from there, the Panthers didn't look back. They went on to win 25-21. All around it was a good experience. Each player had a hand in the win.

Altadena JV Volleyball improved their record to 2 and 0, with a win over Kyrene Middle School on Thursday night. Miranda N. served 14 straight points in the first game and Ava Z. served 12 straight points in the second game. Great job Panthers!

The Varsity volleyball team took on the KMS Scorpions on Thursday night. Game one got off to a quick start with the Panthers taking an 11-8 lead. Avery G. had a huge block that seemed to stun the Scorpions causing them to falter a bit. The Panthers continued to dominate in the back row, digging up everything the Scorpions hit at them. Piper G. went on a serving run of six straight before KMS responded and would side out. Altadeña took game one 25-17. Game two was a slow, back and forth nail biter until the end. The game stayed within a two-point difference for either team most of the game. Nylah R. got hot and went on a streak of three straight kills on big swings pulling the Panthers ahead 19-16, but the scorpions were relentless. The Panthers never gave up and some heads up, scrappy plays by Brooklyn G., Luna P., and Hayley H. allowed the Panthers to pull off the win 25-23 to win the match.


