We discussed the importance of listening to everyone's ideas, and working together to THINK of solutions that make everyone feel okay.

Learning Focus

Skills/Writing We are coming to an end of Unit 8 in skills. Several assessments will be given this week. Some of the testing will include reading real words with up to 5 sounds, tricky words, reading nonsense words, identifying given words, identify letters by names and fluently reading. Continue to practice "Tricky Words": the, a, of, all, from, one, & was at home. It is important that your child can read these words very quickly. More tricky words are to come and staying on top of them and practicing them is critical to their fluent reading.

Reading: In Reading, we finished our domain on Seasons and Weather. We have wrote to our pen pal, Annie, who has helped us to learn all about the 4 seasons and weather. In addition, the students will be introduced to opinion writing. They will choose their favorite season and tell, in their opinion, why it is the best season supported by facts.

Math: In Math, our goal is to find the missing part of 10. They will continue to practice making numbers from two other numbers. They are gaining knowledge and developing the idea that smaller quantities are contained within larger quantities. In addition, they are practicing how to find the missing part of ten by using pictures, 10-frames, counters and connecting cubes. They continue to practice writing equations. New vocabulary included is number pairs, part, and whole.
