Dear First Grade Families,

What a fun week! The kiddos loved guessing each other's baby pictures and clues! We finished our CKLA Fables Unit and will be starting our first lesson on the Human Body next week! Students are really looking forward to learning all the things our bodies can do!

In Skills, we have been blending and segmenting words, nouns, letters and letter sounds, as well as reading phrases. We also practiced building simple CVC words with the different short vowel sounds we've learned so far.

In math, we practiced working with addition word problems. We talked about key words within these problems that are clues to help determine when to add and subtract. Students also practiced pulling out an equation based off the problem and solving it. We practiced using objects to count on as well as the number line. Students should be using one of these two strategies when solving word problems.

In social studies, we learned about several important symbols and landmarks that are important to The United States of America (The Liberty Bell, Washington Monument, Lincoln Memorial, White House, the American Flag, and Bald Eagle just to name few!)
