Dear First Grade Families,

This week in first grade, we “moved” right into our Human Body Unit. We learned about the Skeletal System, Muscular System, Digestive System, and the Circulatory System. The students LOVE learning about their bodies!

In CKLA Skills, we continued with blending and segmenting words. We introduced the /sh/, /ch, and /th/ diagraphs. Students also reviewed tricky words: do, two, one, once, the and who. We also began reading our first Unit 1 reader (in class book)! As we progress through this reader in class, you will see practice readings come home for your student to read to you! These will include phonics sounds and tricky words we have already practiced.

In writing, we are practicing using capital letters at the beginning of a sentence and periods at the end. We practice skills during Daily 5 stations and in our Skills lessons.

In social studies we finished our travels in the United States with visits to the Statue of Liberty, St. Louis Arch and the White House. We then took off to Canada to explore Niagara Falls, the maple tree, and parliament.

In math, we continued to work on combinations. We have been working on our problem solving strategies and how to solve problems efficiently. We worked on fluency to 10 with a few new math games (Head and Tails, Double Compare, and Five-in-a-Row).
