ELA:

Phonemic awareness- practice the ck, and double consonant sounds. Work on tricky words that don't follow their sound (was, when, why, where, what, which, here, there)

This week in language arts, we practiced the ck, ch, sh, th digraph sounds. We continued to read out of our Unit 1 reader. We have been following two characters who have been touring the U.K. We have been answering comprehension questions from the story and doing our best to answer them in complete sentences. We introduced the question mark this week and discussed when it is appropriate to use it while writing.

In our CKLA Listening Domain, we continued our Human Body Unit. We learned about the Circulatory system and Nervous system. We practiced naming important parts of these systems and what they do to keep us healthy.

In math, we started a new unit that helps practice creating number bonds. This will help them make relationships between addition and subtraction. This is also known as fact families. We continued to review combinations of 10 through various games to help them practice these skills.

In social studies, we moved on to our next country within North America, CANADA! We studied some famous symbols like the maple tree, maple leaf, Inukshuk, & totem poles. We looked at some live webcams of beavers and polar bears and discussed important facts about them. We even created a beaver puppet in which I'm sure you heard all about.
